May 2012

Overgrowth restricting access to the stile removed and 5 new steps and a handrail installed up a slippery bank

Northampton (Upton)



April 2012

5 new steps and a handrail up a steep bank leading on to Upton Way North road, which links the A4500 with the Pineham and Swan Valley Business Parks

Old





March 2012

Two embankments on the same footpath in the sports ground, one requiring 10 steps and a handrail, the other 4 steps only

Great Addington



November 2011

Installation of 3 new steps and a replacement stile. The gap between the upper and lower rails was made deliberately wide at the request of the landowner

Twywell



July 2011 – Installation of 6 new steps and a handrail from a road to the field boundary

Lowick



July 2011 – Installation of 6 replacement steps and a handrail from a field up to a road

Towcester (Wood Burcote)



June 2011 – Refurbished 9 steps and installed new handrail

Marston Trussell



June 2011 – Installed 7 new steps and a handrail up an old railway embankment

Dingley



April 2011. Footpath between Market Harborough and Dingley. Six new steps plus handrail

Duddington & Finshade Wood



March 2011. Footpath MX2 (west side of A43) - 10 new steps and handrail on embankment to road.



March 2011. Footpath MX3 (east side of A43) - 12 new steps and handrail on embankment to road

Collyweston



February 2011. Installation of 4 steps and a handrail on a newly created footpath linking Collyweston village with the Jurassic Way long distance footpath

Potterspury





January 2011. Undertook extensive clearance work and removed existing dilapidated steps. Installed 16 new ones dressed with stone and a handrail

Harpole/Nobottle





Footpath between Harpole and Nobottle. Refurbishment of 19 existing steps and installation of 4 new ones and a handrail. November 2010.

Ditchford Lane, Wellingborough





Three sets of steps surfaced with granite stone (19 steps in all) installed at Ditchford Lane, Wellingborough in October 2010, giving improved links to the Nene Way, one of Northamptonshire's Long Distance Paths

Brackley



26 steps, surfaced with granite stone, and a handrail installed at Brackley during November & December 2009. This greatly improves the village path between Brackley and Whitfield

Ecton



4 new steps in place of a sharp bank at Ecton installed in October 2009
A great improvement on the Ecton to Earls Barton footpath
